The university network is now fully powered over ethernet. Also, all backbone connections are now upgraded to 20 Gbps link aggregation control protocols. Their core switches are now 40 Gbps links to the DMZ, running through a firewall.

Since the implementation, the UP is now covered by 802.11n dual-channel wireless network, and will use the new 802.11ac standard in all new halls.

FINANCIAL

Thanks to Alcatel-Lucent Enterprise's solutions, the university saved \$120,000 this year. Two virtual laboratories were created by utilizing the BYOD concept, and thus additional investment was not necessary.
